This year's Annual Scientific Meeting offers participants more than ever as COMP and CARO combine two exciting programs into one joint meeting in Toronto, October 10 to 13, 2007. The preconference program starts on Wednesday with the CARO Resident's Refresher Course, a half day Brachytherapy Symposium co-sponsored by the Canadian Brachytherapy Group, and an all day symposium exploring the expanding role of MR in Radiation Medicine.

The formal joint program runs Thursday to Saturday. Abstracts were solicited for joint CARO-COMP general paper and poster sessions, and the Resident and Young Investigator Paper Competition.

New this year was a submission and peer review process for educational refresher courses, symposia and skills building workshops, which will be run concurrently on Friday and Saturday. Here is your opportunity to contribute your knowledge and expertise to the program in innovative learning formats!

Participants can also attend a CARO-CCPM sponsored theme symposium on adaptive radiation therapy, and listen to three keynote speakers over the course of the program: Dr. David Jaffray, the 2007 CARO Lecturer, Dr. Glenn Bauman, the 2007 Gordon Richards Lecturer and the 2007 COMP Gold Medalist. New to CARO is the addition of the COMP public lecture Thursday night. Dr. Jean-Philippe Pignol will speak on innovative radiation treatments in breast cancer and a breast cancer community advocate will share her personal story. As usual, a number of other related activities such as business meetings, CCPM examinations, and

special interest groups meetings, will precede the ASM on Tuesday October 9, and be interspersed throughout.

The Joint CARO-COMP Awards Dinner promises a fun and exciting close to a busy five days.
