“Living With Death”



Sheldon Solomon is Professor of Psychology at Skidmore College in Saratoga Springs, New York.

As an experimental social psychologist, his interests include the nature of self, consciousness, and social behavior. His work exploring the effects of the uniquely human awareness of death on individual and social behavior has been supported by the National Science Foundation and Ernest Becker Foundation and was featured in the award winning documentary film *Flight from Death: The Quest for Immortality*; he is co-author *In the Wake of 9/11: The Psychology of Terror* (2003, American Psychological Association Books) and co-founder of *The World Leaders Project*.

Dr. Solomon is a Fellow in the American Psychological Society, a 2007 recipient of an American Psychological Association Presidential Citation, and 2009 recipient of a Lifetime Career Award by The International Society for Self and Identity
