Dr. Charles Catton



Dr Charles Catton has been on staff as a Radiation Oncologist at the Princess Margaret Hospital in Toronto since 1989.

He is a clinical trialist with a particular interest in the development of high-precision radiotherapy techniques for prostate cancer and soft-tissue sarcomas. He has conducted and participated in phase II and III testing of radiotherapy techniques for soft-tissue sarcomas, and is currently leading one OCOG-sponsored international trial investigating hypo-fractionated radiotherapy for prostate cancer, and is the national PI for a trial co-sponsored by NCIC-CTG and MRC-UK investigating multimodality treatment for localized prostate cancer.

Dr Catton is Professor of Radiation Oncology and the Director of the Radiation Oncology Fellowship Program at the University of Toronto.

He is the GU Oncology Site Leader at The University Health Network and is also a Radiation Oncology representative on the GU Clinical Trials Group Executive Committee of the NCIC-CTG.
