The one-week, intensive resident training course offers a unique opportunity for about 80 young oncologists to learn the essentials of clinical trials and be in direct contact with experts in this specific field.

This is **CROF's** third year in providing support to the FLIMS Workshop by sponsoring **one CARO candidate** with a proposal in radiation oncology to attend the Workshop.

Dr. Chung completed her residency in BC and recently completed a research fellowship concurrently with a Masters of Science at the Institute of Medical Science at the University of Toronto and the Clinician Investigator Program through the University of British Columbia. She is a new investigator at PMH with subspecialty focuses on Breast Cancer, CNS and Ocular malignancies. Her research interests include the using imaging and biofluid biomarkers to predict response and move towards individualized cancer therapy.
