The minimum selection criteria for the Workshop are the following:

- Be a **Senior Radiation Oncology** resident or fellow within 5 years of completion of training;
- Be a **CARO member** in good standing;
- Be eligible to work in **Canada** after completion of training;
- Have a **major** interest in clinical research and have the intention to develop a career in that field;
- Aim to **write and conduct a clinical protocol** for a study not previously performed which is also;
- considered feasible within the institutional setting and the time of completion of the clinical training of the candidate;
- Be **fluent in written and spoken English** and have good computer skills;
- Have **support from the Supervisor/Head of Department** and sustained commitment in the years following the Workshop;
- **Only** the CARO member with the highest score as per the ECCO selection process will be sponsored by CROF;
- The CROF recipient is expected to provide a written report to CROF upon completion of the workshop and prior to the 2012 ASM.
