The Canadian Radiation Oncology Foundation (CROF) is pleased to announce that Dr. Harvey Quon is the recipient of the First Annual CROF-Flims Grant. Dr. Quon will be attending the 11<sup>th</sup> joint **ECCO - AACR - ASCO** Workshop on “*Methods in Clinical Cancer Research*” at the Park Hotels Waldhaus, Flims, Switzerland, June 20 – 26, 2009.

This one-week, intensive resident training course offers a unique opportunity for about 80 young oncologists to learn the essentials of clinical trials and be in direct contact with experts in this specific field.

For the first time since its inception, **CROF** is participating in sponsoring young researchers in this field; and in particular **CROF** will be supporting one CARO candidate with a proposal in radiation oncology<sup>1</sup>.

As a medical student, Dr. Quon conducted research during the summers in the laboratories of Dr. Dele Davies and Dr. Irene Wanke at the University of Calgary. After beginning residency in Radiation Oncology, Dr. Quon conducted multiple clinical research studies under the supervision of Drs. Wilson Roa, Nadeem Pervez, Bassam Abdulkarim, and Joseph Kurian at the Cross Cancer Institute in Edmonton, Canada.

He will be undertaking a research fellowship in genitourinary malignancies at the Odette Cancer Centre / Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre for the next 1-2 years.
