Dr. James Morris

Dr. Morris is one of the founders and the former head of the British Columbia Provincial Prostate Brachytherapy Program (1997-2008) which is the largest prostate brachytherapy program in Canada having done more than 3000 implants to date. He and his colleagues have published > 25 refereed publications and have presented dozens of abstracts at national and international meeting detailing various aspects of brachytherapy for prostate cancer. In addition to a full time clinical practise in radiation oncology, Dr. Morris holds a number of peer-reviewed and industry-sponsored research grants, participates in the supervision of clinical/research fellows, graduate students, radiation oncology residents and medical undergraduates. He is currently the chair of the Brachytherapy Quality Assurance Committee and is the principle investigator for developmental brachytherapy at the Vancouver Cancer Centre.
