



LOCUM RADIATION ONCOLOGIST required, Tom Baker Cancer Centre, CALGARY

The Tom Baker Cancer Centre (TBCC) in Calgary is seeking a **LOCUM Radiation Oncologist for 3 to 6 months, starting immediately. Expertise with CNS disease or Stereotactic Radiosurgery would be an asset but not mandatory.**

The TBCC is a full-service, academic cancer centre with 20 Radiation Oncologists, 8 linear accelerators, and both LDR and HDR brachytherapy capacity. The TBCC hosts the provincial Alberta Radiosurgery Centre and expanding programs for lung, liver and spine SBRT. In 2016, faculty provided 4000 consultations. There are close interdisciplinary working relationships with Medical, Surgical, Gynecologic, Hematologic and Psychosocial Oncology, Palliative Care, and Medical Physics

The University of Calgary's Radiation Oncology Residency Training Program, post-residency Radiation Oncology fellowships and post-graduate programs in Surgical, Medical, Gynecologic, and Hematologic Oncology and Palliative Medicine are all active at TBCC. There are opportunities to teach medical students, residents and fellows from a variety of disciplines.

Calgary is a growing city with a vibrant cultural scene and ready access to outdoor activities in Kananaskis Country (1 hour from TBCC) and Banff, Lake Louise and the Rockies (1.5 hours).

Qualifications:

You must have an MD degree and Canadian specialist certification in Radiation Oncology, or the equivalent. You must be eligible for licensure as a specialist by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta and for appointment to the medical staff of Alberta Health Services. Preference will be given to Canadian citizens or those with permanent resident status.

Compensation:

Remuneration will depend on clinical experience and comply with the agreement between Cancer Control Alberta, Alberta Health Services and the Alberta Medical Association. The duration of the locum will be a minimum of 3 months but depend on your availability (start date) and the outcome of a recruitment process for a permanent staff position that will be conducted through the fall of 2017. Further details are available upon request. Radiation Oncologists may be either AHS employees or independent contractors.

The start date is as soon as the successful candidate can make themselves available.
