

RADIATION ONCOLOGIST WALKER FAMILY CANCER CENTRE & NIAGARA HEALTH

We're seeking a candidate for a full time Radiation Oncology position at the Walker Family Cancer Centre in St. Catharines, Ontario.

The Walker Family Cancer Centre (WFCC) opened in March 25th 2013 offering patients in the Niagara region radiation treatment close to home. Radiation Oncology consultation, treatment planning and treatment as well as follow-up is offered at the WFCC. Disease sites treated at the WFCC include cancers of the Breast, Prostate, Lung, lower GI malignancies and Skin cancers and palliative radiation therapy. Many of these treatment disease sites involve multidisciplinary care coordination with medical oncology, supportive care, palliative care or other hospitals. The formation of the multidiscipline Lung Diagnostic Assessment Program (L-DAP) and Prostate Diagnostic Assessment Programs (P-DAP) as well as telemedicine consultation facilitate rapid consultation and access to treatment. Radiation Oncologists at the WFCC also are cross-affiliated with the Juravinski Cancer Centre at Hamilton Health Sciences in Hamilton.

The successful applicant will become a member of a multidisciplinary cancer program and will join a team of medical, and radiation oncologists, nurse practitioners and support staff. Opportunities exist in participation in multidisciplinary diagnostic programs (DAP) in the GU and lung sites, in implementation of new technologies such as C-RAD.

The Department of Radiation Oncology is part of the integrated radiation program with the department of radiation oncology at Juravinski Cancer Centre and part of the Hamilton, Niagara, Haldimand, Brant, and Burlington HNH B LHIN serving 1.4 million people.

Niagara region is the geographic area, which the WFCC serves and consists of 12 municipalities with a total population of 431,346 residents. It is located in southern Ontario, between Lake Ontario and Lake Erie and covers a land area of 1,854.2 km². The Niagara region is known for its unique natural landscapes with outstanding trails, wineries, the Horseshoe Falls, Niagara –on – the lake, the Shaw festival and the Welland canal. It is also close to major airports like Toronto and Buffalo, beaches, ski resorts and major cities like Toronto is an hour away.

The successful applicant will be expected to deliver excellent patient care and must be eligible for licensure in Ontario and must have fellowship in Radiation Oncology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeon. Remuneration will be commensurate with experience. A formal academic position will be separately negotiated through the Department of Oncology, Faculty of Health Sciences at McMaster University. Academic interest will be prioritized.
