2018 Clinical Research Radiation Oncology Fellowships

The BC Cancer Agency (BCCA) manages a comprehensive cancer control program for the people of British Columbia. It operates regional cancer centres in Abbotsford, Kelowna, Surrey, Vancouver, Victoria and Prince George.

The BC Cancer Agency has Clinical Research Fellowships available. While all centres are focused on delivering excellent care, the focus in research varies by centre and may be tailored to the interests of the fellow. In the past, fellows have successfully led projects examining RT technical innovations, including brachytherapy and capitalized on the availability of provincial data resources to complete population-based outcomes evaluation projects.

Fellowship candidates must be physicians who have completed training in Radiation Oncology suitable to practice as a specialist in their home country and have demonstrated ability in basic or clinical research. Candidates should be looking for a one- or possibly two-year opportunity to expand on these skills. The selected candidates will be expected to spend approximately half their time in clinical activities and half in research. Fellow-led research projects should be completed within the tenure of the posts.

Fellows will be registered as post-graduate trainees with the University of British Columbia.
