

## **Fellowship in Lower GI Oncology**

A **funded** fellowship position is presently available for a period of 12 months in lower GI cancer starting **July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018** at the Jewish General Hospital, McGill University, in Montreal, Canada.

The successful candidate will be exposed to a large practice of lower GI tumors, the opportunity to acquire experience in HDR endorectal brachytherapy (HDRBT) in neoadjuvant and radical treatment of patients with rectal cancer, IMRT treatment of pelvic tumors and SBRT of patients with oligometastases. During this fellowship, the candidate will learn to evaluate and monitor patients with rectoscopy evaluation, imaging, will be exposed to 50 kv endocavitary technologies for early rectal cancer and will have the opportunity to participate to translation and clinical trials. In particular, a randomized trial comparing chemotherapy and external beam radiation to same regiment and HDRBT boost for operable T2-3N0 rectal cancer with main objective organ preservation for those patients with complete clinical response.

Montreal is a bilingual city and it will be a major advantage for the candidate to speak English and French.
