

Survey Guidelines:

CARO will consider individual requests to circulate messages, solicitations or surveys to the membership on behalf of individuals or groups if they meet the following criteria:

- Must be a CARO member who has renewed their dues for the current year
- Are broadly relevant to the practice of Radiation Oncology in Canada, and deemed to be of general interest to the majority of the membership
- In the case of policy development, is supported by the CARO Board as having potentially important implications for Radiation Oncology in Canada
- In the case of research, is supported by the CARO Executive as having potentially important
 implications for Radiation Oncology in Canada, and has undergone independent scientific and
 ethical review. Evidence of scientific assessment will include but not be limited to peer review
 reports from external funding agencies or local institutional research review boards. All
 proposals must be approved by the Research Ethics Board of the host institution.

Notes

- Dissemination of a survey link is free for CARO members (\$500 for other)
- Centres (University or Hospital), may not allow access to surveys hosted on Survey Monkey
- Surveys will be reviewed by the CARO Executives; Please allow a turn-around time of up to three weeks for survey review. Additional time may be required for survey distribution.
